## PREDICTIVE POLICING IS HERE IN PITTSBURGH

The Pittsburgh Bureau of Police has been using a predictive policing model since a 2016 pilot in **Homewood**. It is now deployed **across half the city.** 

This model predicts crime "hotspots" to **proactively police communities** through patrols. Although the model has been in use for three years, **affected communities have not been informed** of its potential consequences.

# WHY WORRY ABOUT PREDICTIVE POLICING?

Black youth in Pittsburgh are already arrested 2.5x the national average. (For black adults, it's 1.5x national average). Pittsburgh's predictive policing model could worsen racial disparities in policing by concentrating policing in already over-policed neighborhoods. The model in particular may use arrests for minor crimes -- which are often correlated with black and Hispanic populations -- to predict future serious crimes.

## WHO WANTED PREDICTIVE POLICING?

Pittsburgh's model was developed under Chief McClay by researchers at CMU, and initially piloted in August 2016 in Homewood. At the request of Mayor Peduto, **despite ethics concerns**, a renewed city-wide experiment launched May 2017, funded by the Richard King Mellon Foundation as a CMU Metro 21 research project.

# **HOW HAS PREDICTIVE POLICING AFFECTED OTHER CITIES?**

Predictive policing has often targeted innocent citizens, increased racial bias, lacked transparency, and been ineffective at reducing crime.

#### CHICAGO

Implementation of the **CrimeScan** model showed that "predictive crime mapping further entrenches and legitimizes racialized policing." Expansion of the program created a **secretive list of ~90,000 people** as most likely to be involved with violent crime. This list has been used to make arrests. (The creator of CrimeScan co-created Pittsburgh's model.)

## **NEW YORK**

Civil liberties advocates had to sue the NYPD just to receive basic information regarding which companies were being contracted for predictive policing. The city's argument was that this was "proprietary information."

## LOS ANGELES

The Stop LAPD Spying Coalition conducted a survey that found the predictive policing program exacerbated racial bias by leading to more minority interactions with police in areas that were already over-policed. After an audit in 2019, the LAPD suspended the use of some of their predictive policing models.

## **NEW ORLEANS**

The predictive policing program was unknown to the public for six years until it was covered by journalists. Questions remain as to how effective it was at preventing crime.
